## HOW TO GET TO THE CROWN OIL ARENA

#### By Road (Please use OL11 5DR for Sat Navs)

From either the East or West via the M62: The Crown Oil Arena is just over two miles from junction 20 of the M62.

Follow signs for Rochdale along the A627(M). At the first set of traffic lights keep left, sign posted Bury and Rochdale Town Centre. The Trade Centre UK will be on your right hand side, follow this road until the next set of traffic lights. Here you need to be in the second lane of four lanes, to head straight across (sign posted Blackburn). Follow this road (Roch Valley Way) until the next set of traffic lights, remaining in the left hand lane. At the traffic lights go straight ahead on to Sandy Lane (the Cemetery pub should be on your right hand side). Continue along this road and the Stadium is on your right hand side after approximately half a mile.

#### **By Rail**

Rochdale train station, which is served by trains from Manchester Victoria and Leeds, is around 2.5 miles and a 40-45 minute walk from the Crown Oil Arena. Taxis are available outside the station at a cost of around  $\pm 7/\pm 8$ .

#### **By Bus**

#### The Crown Oil Arena is around a 25-30 minute walk from Rochdale Town Centre.

## WHERE TO SIT/ STAND AT THE CROWN OIL ARENA

Home supporters have the option to sit or stand at the Crown Oil Arena.

The David Kilpatrick Stand (Main Stand), which runs the length of the pitch, and the Smith Metals Family Stand, behind the goal, offers seating, while the Sandy Lane end offers the option to stand. All three stands are covered.

The Smith Metals Family Stand is also home to our junior fanzone, Desmond's Den! Take your seat in the Joshua McCormack Family Enclosure after taking part in our Junior Event in Desmond's Den. More information on this area is available further down this guide.

Turnstiles open an hour before kick-off.



# **ADMISSION DETAILS**

## There are no cash turnstiles at the Crown Oil Arena.

The quickest and easiest way to purchase tickets for a fixture is online at https://www.rafcshop.co.uk/tickets

Tickets remain online up until kick-off. You can save your e-ticket, which will be emailed to you, directly to your phone to scan upon entry to the turnstiles. Or you can print off your e-ticket and bring it with you to the game. If you prefer not to buy online, you can call the Ticket Office at the Crown Oil Arena prior to matchday to buy your tickets - 01706 644 648 (option 1), or visit the Crown Oil Arena in person.

In addition to buying online on matchday, you can purchase tickets from the stadium by cash or card. If purchasing for the David Kilpatrick Main Stand, visit the Ticket Office. If purchasing for the Sandy Lane or Smith Metals Family Stand, visit the Club Shop. Please allow plenty of time to do so, as there will be queues in the build-up to kick-off.

# WHERE TO PARK

The Crown Oil Arena has a small car park which can accommodate hospitality guests and staff only. Street parking is available around the stadium, however please be aware that parking restrictions are in place in the yellow coned areas – these are monitored by traffic control. Please park courteously in public areas

# **VISITING COACHES**

On the instructions of the police ALL coaches with visiting supporters must park, drop-off and pick up on Ings Lane. Supporters will then make their way on foot to the Stadium. Under NO circumstances must coaches' drop-off or pick-up on either Sandy Lane or Willbutts Lane.



#### SATNAV: Use Post Code OL12 7AL

Leave the M62 at junction 20, onto A627M (SIGNPOSTED ROCHDALE) At the end of A627M turn left into EDINBURGH WAY. At the next junction straight through the traffic lights onto ROCH VALLEY WAY At the next lights turn right onto BURY ROAD (Cemetery public house on opposite corner). At the next lights turn left onto MELLOR STREET At the 1st mini roundabout take second exit (straight on). At the 2nd mini roundabout take second exit (straight on) into ROOLEY MOOR ROAD The 10th road on the left is INGS LANE. Turn left and park in the coned area. Steward will guide supporters to the Stadium. COACHES ARE TO PARK IN THE AREAS MARKED WITH CONES.

## SMITH METALS FAMILY STAND/ DESMOND'S DEN A

#### Got a youngster? Why not join us in the Joshua McCormack Family Enclosure which is located in the Smith Metals Family Stand.

You'll find the family enclosure in the last two blocks of the stand, closest to the Main Stand. You'll be able to identify the area by looking out for the blue 'Enjoy the Match' signage which is visible around the area.

Our mascot is a friendly dragon named Desmond. You'll find him in and around the family area on a matchday, as well as in Desmond's Den. Make sure you say hello!

Desmond's Den, situated inside the Smith Metals Family Stand, is open before every Dale home game, with our Junior Events being held in there.

There are games for youngsters to play, as well PlayStation 4s with the latest FIFA game on them!

In order to enter Desmond's Den, supporters must go through the Smith Metals Family Stand turnstiles. You cannot enter Desmond's Den from the car park.

Turnstiles will open an hour before kick-off, for both Tuesday night weekday evenings and Saturday games.

#### Visit Desmond's Den from other stands

Fans in other stands who wish to visit Desmond's Den can now do so, following the relaxation of Covid restrictions. So if you want to take part in the activities but you or your youngster has a season/match ticket elsewhere in the ground, then simply visit the Dale Ticket Office in the run up to kick-off with your season/match tickets, and you will receive a junior matchday club pass. This will allow entry into Desmond's Den from elsewhere in the ground and will permit access for your return to the Main Stand or Sandy Lane.

## THINGS TO DO AT THE GROUND

Join us in the Ratcliffe Bars and Our Spot Community Hub, both of which are situated at the stadium. They are licensed premises, showing TNT Sports.

The Ratcliffe Bars are open to both home and away supporters, whilst Our Spot is open to home fans only.

The Ratcliffe Bars open at 11am on a Saturday (3pm kick-off) matchday, and from 5pm on a midweek matchday (7.45pm kick-off).

Our Spot is accessible from inside the Smith Metals Family Stand only. Turnstiles open one hour before kick-off for this and all stands.

Our Spot is perfect for supporters with families, as it houses Desmond's Den, which is the home our friendly mascot and is packed with things for youngsters to do, including PS4s and junior workshops.

You can also visit our Club Shop, located at the back of the Smith Metals Family Stand, to pick up a wide-range of merchandise and souvenirs.







#### Visit our Fan Zone in the Ratcliffe Bar!

Enjoy an extended happy hour (selected drinks), from 11-12.30pm (Saturday 3pm matchday), and watch the early kick-off on TNT Sports (should a match be being broadcast), or from 5pm-6pm on a midweek matchday (7.45pm kick-off). In there is also a pool table and table football for supporters young and old to enjoy.

The Fan Zone will also be open after the game for the Man of the Match presentation.

# KIOSKS

You'll find kiosks in the concourses around the ground, which sell a range of hot and cold food, as well as drinks.

Our new catering partners for the 2023/24 season, Scratch Catering, have some delicious items on their menu!

Make sure you get into the ground early to sample some of their food before the game.

# DRUMS, BANNERS & FLAGS

Drums are allowed into the ground, although this is reviewed on a match by match basis. If this policy changes, spectators will be notified via social media.

Banners are allowed in the home end. A fire safety certificate is required for all banners over 7ft x 3ft. All fire rating documents should be supplied before banners can enter the stadium. Approach a steward who will show the best place the banners can be placed. We do not allow any banner considered offensive to be put on display. If a supporter is unsure whether the content is offensive they can contact the club's Supporter Liaison Officer (Nicola Toolan) by emailing nicola.toolan@rochdaleafc.co.uk



No flags on poles are allowed.

# **NO FLARES & PYROTECHNICS**
